The money raised by this authorization will provide funds to increase technology access for students and staff through the acquisition, installation, replacement, support, and maintenance of software, applications, digital curriculum and resources, mobile devices, improved technology, technology systems, networks, and infrastructure, and related training. The proposed capital project levy authorization will raise approximately \$3,500,000 for taxes payable in 2015, the first year it is to be levied, and would be authorized for ten years. The estimated total cost of the projects to be funded over that time period is approximately \$35,000,000.
