Having filed to run in a general election for three RAS Board positions are five candidates: Helen J. Bassett, Ron Stoffel, Sherry Tyrrell, Peter Vasseur and John Vento. The general election will be held Tuesday, November 6.

The Robbinsdale Area School Board consists of seven members who represent all residents of the school district for four-year terms.

In addition to its more than 11,000 K-12 students, Robbinsdale Area Schools also serves a large population of preschool and adult learners. The district operates schools in an area that includes all or parts of Brooklyn Center, Brooklyn Park, Crystal, Golden Valley, New Hope, Plymouth and Robbinsdale.

The League of Women Voters, host of this candidate forum, is a nonpartisan organization which encourages the informed and active participation of citizens in government, works to increase understanding of major public policy issues, and influences public policy through education and advocacy.
