


Opportunity Zones in Hennepin County

What are opportunity zones?

The 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act created Opportunity Zones as a new federal economic development tool that provides a tax incentive to invest in low-income urban and rural communities nationwide. Opportunity Zones have the potential to draw long-term private investment to areas that are in the most economic need. On May 18, 2018, the U.S. Department of Treasury certified and formally designated 128 [census tracts](#) in the State of Minnesota as qualified Opportunity Zones, including 25 in Hennepin County.
